## MSA SECURITY and BOSCH PROJECT EARN SECURITY INNOVATION AWARDS GOLD MEDAL

New York, NY, November 29, 2016 . . . MSA Security and Bosch received the 2016 Gold Award of Excellence for security innovation in the category of National Public Safety Explosives and Weapons Detection Screener Support System Project at Secured Cities earlier this month.

The award recognized MSA Security, Bosch Security Systems, SecureXperts and Genetec for a collaborative government project that integrated MSA's SmartTech<sup>™</sup> into Bosch's Credentialed High Assurance Video Encryption (CHAVE®) cyber secure IP video system. The technology solution was developed for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to improve nationwide explosive screening methods of vehicles, packages and other items with real-time access to FBI-certified bomb technicians for immediate assessment of the suspicious or unusual items.

Using SmartTech<sup>™</sup>, digital images and video that are captured from current screening machines and other technologies are securely transmitted using Bosch's CHAVE enabled cameras, which is the only camera portfolio with full end-to-end encryption using FIPS Publication 140-2 Level 3 certified encryption standards. The Genetec Security Center video management system captures each screening area and records the action of the individuals, screeners and packages into a single scene view.

The innovative collaboration of Bosch, SecureXperts, Genetec and MSA Security has resulted in a truly state-of-the-art risk mitigation solution that meaningfully addresses the growing threat of improvised explosive devices," said Darnell Washington,
