

Phase 1 Reopening Considerations



Phase 1 of reopening in most states includes the construction industry. For most of our clients this means increased activity at the loading dock as crews and supplies pass through. A breach at the loading dock could allow hostile actors to gain entry, impart damage, or secrete weapons. Security at this access point and throughout the building is a critical component of a safe and successful restart.

Loading Dock Security

- ✓ Plan a gradual restart to avoid overwhelming operations
- Implement temperature / health screening for all entrants
- ✓ Test all equipment such as X-ray machines and magnetometers
- Review security protocols with your employees and vendors
- Conduct refresher training digitally and in-person when possible
- ✓ Prepare for new threats in the post COVID environment, such as civil unrest
- Project a hard perimeter to deter hostile actors
- Coordinate penetration testing to identify potential vulnerabilities
