

# U.S. Best Practices for Phased Reopening

Throughout the United States, phased reopening is occurring at different rates and in different ways across regions and industries. Click on states below to learn about resources and best practices across the country.



## California

Hollywood is Southern California's largest industry supporting over 2 million jobs. The industry is planning its reopening using an integrated approach that includes the identification of COVID-19 Workplace Coordinators for each work site.



## New York

Partial business reopening could begin as soon as June 1st in New York, following a plan that must meet 3 Business Safety Precautions: Protection for Employees and Customers, Changes to the Physical Workspace, and Implementing processes that meet Public Health Obligations, including screening on entry.

## Illinois

Commercial real estate giant, Jones Lang LaSalle, has issued 10 focus areas for workplace re-entry, including considerations for floor plan modifications that ensure social distancing.



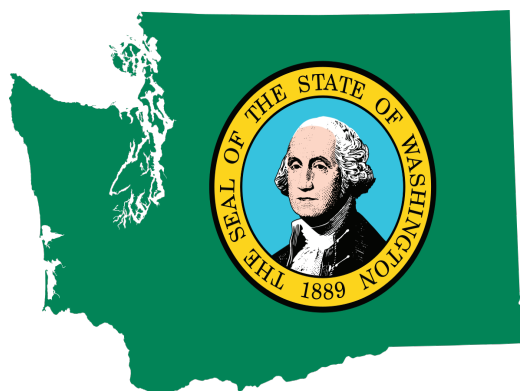
## Virginia

The Virginia Tourism Corporation has created a COVID-19 Response Toolkit that includes business assistance resources for various industries affected by tourism declines from restaurants and hotels to entertainment venues.



## Michigan

Michigan manufacturer Lear Corporation compiled a 51 page "Safe Work Playbook" manual that was made public on its website inclusive of health screening, signage, floor plans, and employee training.



## Washington

Washington based Madrona Venture Group surveyed some of the state's largest companies from Amazon to Microsoft and compiled a comprehensive toolkit for reopening post-COVID.
